# Kid's Camper Check List

## What to Bring

(Mark items with name to avoid loss)

- Rugged, older clothes
- Swimsuit – Modest & appropriate (No 2 piece swimsuits, no bikinis)
- Warm jacket or sweatshirt for cold nights
- Long pants & socks for hiking
- Hat and sunglasses (optional)
- Closed toe shoes for hiking and rock wall
- Flip-flops for use in shower
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Large towel, washcloth, etc.
- Soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc.
- Sunscreen (optional)
- Bug repellent (optional)
- Chap stick
- Refillable Water Bottle
- Bible, pen or pencil
- Flashlight



## Medication

Camper can ONLY bring prescription medication in original bottles/containers labeled with child's name. Medication in any other name will not be dispensed to child. All non-prescription medication must be in original container. Parents, please give detailed directions as to when and under what circumstances medication should be given to your child. Please include signature & phone number. All medications should be placed into a Ziploc bag with child's name and given to the camp nurse or adult taking your camper to camp.

## What NOT to Bring

Spending money, this has been added to the registration fee and there is no need for more.

Knives, weapons or dangerous objects

Tobacco, drugs, alcohol

Matches, lighters, fireworks

Electronic Devices (Gameboys, cell phones, computers, tablets, etc.) If these items are brought we will hold them in the director's cabin until close of camp.

Jewelry that might get lost or stolen

Inappropriate reading or pictorial material

### CAMP MAIL

One of the highlights of the camp experience is getting mail from home. Letters only please. There are plenty of snacks available at the snack shop. Please do not send large boxes of snacks to your camper.

You will need to mail items by the Friday before camp starts at the latest for the camper to receive it before camp is over. You may also be able to send it by Monday or Tuesday with expedited shipping.

Faster mail is to send mail with the driver or hand it to the registration desk and list which day your child should receive it.

### SWIMWEAR/ATTIRE

All swim wear needs to be modest and appropriate. One piece swim suits only. Campers will be asked to wear a t-shirt over any suit deemed inappropriate or that is 2 piece.

Undergarments and boxers should not be seen.

Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times when not in swim area or when required for a recreation activity.

### SPENDING MONEY

There is no need to send spending money to camp. **Included in the registration fee is an amount of the snack bar that will be distributed to the children each day**

### MEDICATION

All medication must be checked in with the Nurse at check-in – even inhalers or other medicine that the campers may need to keep themselves must be checked in so that we have a record of what medicines are being taken at the campground and by whom in case of any emergencies. All medicines need to be in the original bottle – both prescription and non-prescription medicines.

**If you child has been prescribed with an inhaler you MUST send it to camp. Due to the amount of dust in the air and high elevation asthma tends to kick in more readily.**

### **ARRIVAL TIME**

Check-in for camp is Sunday, July 30th at 3:00 PM. Please do not plan to arrive or check in before this time as the campground will not be ready before this time and it will delay us from being able to get checked in and to our cabins in a timely manner. There are hiking trails, a campground and a restaurant nearby to explore if you arrive early.

### **DEPARTURE TIME**

Camp will end Thursday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10:00 AM. We will be having a short Worship Service prior to dismissal and invite and encourage you to arrive early enough to be part of this chapel time. We strongly encourage everyone to stay for this last chapel as it allows God another service to either do something, continue something He has already started, or to just provide encouragement for the journey. We will be celebrating what God has done during the week and offering a prayer of blessing over the kids as they head home. Campers will be dismissed to their drivers from the chapel time. Please sign out your campers, pick up any medication that is there and then go to the chapel to pick up your campers.

### **DIRECTIONS TO SUGAR PINE CHRISTIAN CAMP**

#### **From Oakhurst**

- Take CA-41 North Approximately 10 miles. (You will pass the Bass Lake turn off and then go about 6 miles further)
- Watch for the Camp Sugar Pine Sign on the right side of the road and turn off following signs to the camp.
